

DURSLEY SCULPTURE AND PLAY TRAIL ARTIST/COMMUNITY GROUPS AGREEMENT

Thank you for your helping with the development of the Dursley Sculpture and Play Trail. Your support for the project is important to Vale Vision and The Twinberrow Foundation. With your help the project will be making a significant contribution to the provision of a community trail suitable for all ages in our woodlands.

The Partnership

The Dursley Sculpture and Play Trail partnership includes representatives from Vale Vision and The Twinberrow Foundation, together with business sponsors and funders. Many community groups, schools, colleges, day centres, care homes, youth clubs and artists have been involved in developing the trail.

The Trail

The trail is based in Twinberrow Wood along the road leading from the top of Whiteway to Stinchcombe Hill Golf Club. Although the overall responsibility for the safety of the trail in the woodlands remains with the Twinberrow Trust, safe design and checking of sculptures is the responsibility of Vale Vision. With this in mind we need to check that your sculpture design ideas, materials, locating and securing the sculpture will be safe for users of the trail and surrounding woodland.

Artists and Community Groups

Vale Vision needs to have advance discussions with regard to sculpture design, size, materials, and how you plan for the sculpture to be positioned whether hanging or on the ground. Vale Vision will then need to liaise with the woodland steward appointed by The Twinberrow Trust to ensure that all sculptures can be positioned safely.

The art pieces

Art work should be of a safe height dependent upon its shape, which will be negotiated and agreed, it should not have sharp edges or be coated in any materials injurious to health. If it is intended to be hung or fixed in the trees, we will need to be consulted on this before any work is commenced so that we can negotiate the method of fixing dependant on its shape, material and size. Once sited individual art pieces will form part of the trail and will be checked regularly by Vale Vision. In the event of a piece being considered unsafe or require repair it will be removed and the creator of the sculpture will be informed. The artist or community group may wish to repair the artwork but that would be discussed and negotiated with all parties. Any alterations, additions, movements or replacements of art works must be approved in advance through the partnership.

Publicity, marketing and events.

All parties agree to provide the partnership with notice of any planned publicity or marketing in advance of release. Prior to its launch organised visits can be arranged to the trail - please contact Vale Vision on Tuesdays, Thursday or Friday mornings at 28 Long Street, Dursley or by leaving a message on 01453 544933 when the office is closed or email valevision@btconnect.com .

Sponsorship

Sponsors of groups or artwork will form part of the discussion as to sculpture design and will need to agree that they are happy with the design and sculpture planned. Groups, sponsors, artists will all receive recognition on a plaque mounted on or close to the sculpture.

It is important that all involved negotiate and discuss their plans at an early stage so as to avoid difficulties at a later date.
